## Welcome Back!

The board meetings are open to all members. Meetings are third Thursdays each summer months at the pool. The Reserve Club needs to increase our future membership in order to ensure that membership dues, pool costs and reserves are maintained at reasonable and acceptable levels for 2019 and beyond.

### 2019 Member Dues

Annual dues will be consistent for 2019. **Payments must be made in full, no split payments.** We continue to offer members a referral fee of \$50 for referring in any new full annual memberships. Referral fee does not apply to transfer memberships.

### Equity Blowout

Let your friends know there is a special deal in effect until June 1st: Reduced \$350 membership fee along with the current \$450 dues. This is a *great deal!* Lease memberships have been phased out, recruit new families to join!

### Kid / Teen Fun Nights

We are scheduling both Kid's and Teen Nights again this year. Teen nights are scheduled for the 4th Wednesday of each month. Kids Nights are scheduled for the 3rd Friday of the month. See the dates on the calendar. Based on weather, dates are subject to change.

### Pool Guest Policy

Members are allowed 3 guests at any one time. The daily guest fee is \$5 per person. The same guest is not allowed more than 6 visits per year.

If members have house guests during the summer, you may pay a temporary guest fee of \$20 per guest, per week or \$35 per guest family, per week for a maximum of 3 weeks. You may also register a nanny or caregiver for your children for \$50 per person for the season. Guest passes cannot be used on July 4th.

## **Private Parties and Functions**

Members are invited to reserve the pool for private parties and functions throughout the season (except for July 4th). Private parties are allowed after 7pm except for Tuesdays and Thursdays. The party fee is \$100 (due at the time of your reservation) plus a \$100 refundable damage and cleaning deposit.

Depending on the size of your function, at least two lifeguard are required and the member must pay all guard fees directly. Please coordinate the number of guests with the pool manager.

The pool may be used for kid's parties anytime during the week with **prior**



**reservation and after 2pm on the weekends.** Guest fees apply for kid's parties that are held during normal operating hours. No adult swimmers for kid parties please.

Members who are current with their 2017 dues may request advance party reservations on a first-come, first-served basis beginning May 1st by leaving a message on the club phone line or via email. Reservations may also be made after opening day

party by contacting any pool staff member during normal operating hours. We will provide confirmation of your reservation to you.

## **Payment Policy**

Annual membership payment must be received by **May 15, 2019**

Payments made on the website via credit card will include a 2.9% fee, payable by the member.

A late fee of \$50 will apply for payments not received and paid in full by **May 30th**. Failure to pay by **June 1st** may result in forfeiture of membership per club bylaws.
